Review of Draft Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021
Director Foutz stated that the Finance Committee recommends the budget to the full board for review.

General Manager Gow stated that Lake Hernet MWD has a positive cash flow of 1.3 dollars. Thanked Administrative Services Manager Markham for her work on the budget.

Lake Hemet MWD can save about \$2,650,000 in interest by prepaying the Series 2010 Certificates of Participation with CSDA Finance Corporation and Bank of New York Mellon for LHMWD Pipeline Replacement Project.

Due to the wet winter, we should not have to purchase much water from EMWD. The lake is almost full and is our least expensive source of water.

As it is an election year, \$80,000 has been budgeted for potential election costs. If a board member goes unopposed, that money will not be spent.

Director Pastor inquired about the Southern California Edison bill of \$975,000 and if solar power has been considered. GM Gow stated it was looked into a few years back and that it was not beneficial. As a municipality, we do not get tax credits and it is a long pay back, approximately ten to fourteen years.

Director Foutz, Hemet Unified School District had a private party that contributed the investment for their solar project.

Joe Jorgensen-Hemet –Asked how many full-time employees at Lake Hemet MWD. GM Gow stated it fluctuates.
