Director Foutz stated that fair market value is \$3000 a year and directed GM Gow to amend the agreement to reflect the following changes:

\$3,000 a year, with a credit of \$500 if Mr. Nuciforo incurs the costs of repairing the fence and installing signage on an annual basis.
