California per capita personal income converted to a ratio:

$$\frac{5.73}{100} + \frac{100}{100} = 1.057 \text{ percent}$$

Riverside County population change (01/01/20 – 01/01/21): 0.67 percent

Population change converted to a ratio:

Ratio of change:  $1.007 \times 1.057 = 2.064 \text{ (or } 2.064 \text{ %)}$ 

Appropriations Limit for 2020 – 2021 was: \$6,100,647.40

Appropriations Limit for 2021 - 2022: \$12,591,737.40

Section 7910 of the California Government Code implements Article XIIIB of the California Constitution requires each local jurisdiction to annually establish, by resolution, its appropriations limit for each fiscal year, beginning in 1980-81, and to make the documentation used in determining the appropriations limit available to the public 15 days prior to adoption of the resolution establishing the appropriations limit.
