

## LAKE HEMET MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of Lake Hemet Municipal Water District will adopt a Resolution setting the Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 at the Regular Board meeting to be held Thursday, June 20, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. Calculations made to establish the Appropriations Limit follow:

### 2019 – 2020 Limit

**California per capita personal income change: 3.85 percent \***  
(\* = Cost-of-Living price factor provided by Dept of Finance per capita personal income.)

California per capita personal income converted to a ratio:

$$\frac{3.85}{100} + \frac{100}{100} = 1.039 \text{ percent}$$

**Riverside County population change (01/01/18 – 01/01/19): 1.17 percent**

Population change converted to a ratio:

$$\frac{1.17}{100} + \frac{100}{100} = 1.012$$

Ratio of change: 1.012 x 1.0385 = 1.05096 (or 1.0509 %)

Appropriations Limit for 2018 – 2019 was: \$5,558,854

$$\underline{\$5,558,854 \times 1.05096 = \$5,842,133.20}$$

**Appropriations Limit for 2018 - 2019: \$5,842,133**

Section 7910 of the California Government Code implements Article XIII B of the California Constitution requires each local jurisdiction to annually establish, by resolution, its appropriations limit for each fiscal year, beginning in 1980-81, and to make the documentation used in determining the appropriations limit available to the public 15 days prior to adoption of the resolution establishing the appropriations limit.
